



Dear Parents/Carers,

In order to ensure children's safety, **only children in years 5 and 6** are allowed to walk home on their own. Children in Key Stage 1 need to be collected by an adult (it is not appropriate for an older sibling in Key Stage 2 to walk them home).

This does not mean that all children in years 5 and 6 are ready to walk home on their own. Parents need to consider their child's age, maturity and independence, as well as their distance from school and the safety of the route before making a decision about whether or not it is safe for each child to walk home on their own.

To safeguard all young people at Rosecliff Spencer Academy, if you wish to take responsibility for your child making their own way home from school then we will require written permission from a parent/carer confirming this arrangement.
